Juneau a double election winner

Carol Juneau was a double-winner in last week's general election. Not only was Juneau the top vote-getter in the contest for three seats on the Glacier County Government Study Commission, she was the leading vote-getter in the Town of Browning Government Study Commission race even though she was not running for the position.

Juneau, as a write-in candidate, garnered 27 votes after paper ballots were tallied, but County Clerk and Recorder Donna LaSorte says Juneau cannot serve on both commissions.

That would make Tom McKay with 15 votes, Robert Bremner with 11 and

Joe McKay with 9 the winners for those three positions.

Lloyd Jacobson, the only person to file for one of three City of Cut Bank Government Study Commission seats, garnered 1,211 votes while John Barber got 17 and Billie Wallace 16 as write-ins.

The other paper ballot was for two directors on the Soil Conservation District. Bruce Bradley and Tom Johnson, the only two candidates, were elected. Bradley got 1,860 votes and Johnson 1,811.

LaSorte reported that the official canvass of the election, completed Friday, showed no change in results.
